9. Pair of Females*	Two females
10. Junior Get of Sire	Three animals, summer yearling or younger, get of same bull, both sexes to be represented
11. Pair of Calves*	Two calves

*NOTE: The same two females will not be eligible to show in both Class 9 and 11.

GRADE OR UNREGISTERED PUREBRED ANIMALS BY PUREBRED SIRE

1. Animals entered in the following class cannot be entered in any other class of the Beef Cattle Divisions.
2. BY HIS/HER SIGNATURE AS THE OWNER OR AGENT ON ANY ENTRY FORM, THE EXHIBITOR ALSO CERTIFIES THAT THE SIRE OF EACH ANIMAL ENTERED IN THE FOLLOWING DIVISIONS FOR GRADE ANIMALS WAS EITHER REGISTERED OR PUREBRED.
3. A permanent ear tag or tattoo number is required.
4. Animals which have been registered by a purebred breed association cannot be entered in this Division.
