5. Goats are penned with 4 or 5 in a pen. If you are exhibiting less than 4 goats and have preference with whom you want to be penned, please turn in a written request with your entry forms.
6. No milk out required.
7. For Group Entries, all does must be owned by one exhibitor, entered as individuals and all of one breed.

9. **Don't enter Best Udder of Breed classes, these classes will be judged at ring side.**

24. Produce of Dam	To consist of two daughters from same dam of any age.
25. Best Three Females	Three does of any age bred by exhibitor, need not be related but same breed. One entry per exhibitor.
26. Dairy Herd	Four does in milk. One entry per exhibitor.
